Macs Get Down to Business with VMware Fusion.

Deployed as a desktop standard, in departments with specific business requirements, or permitted as “employee-owned IT,” Macs in the Enterprise work best with VMware Fusion.

VMware Fusion is a key piece of supporting Macs in the Enterprise.

With iPhones already showing up instead of Blackberries, and MacBook Pros and Airs showing up in conference rooms everywhere, *Enterprise desktop administrators need a “Mac in the Enterprise” strategy.* VMware Fusion is a key part of that strategy.

▪ Need a Mac. Need PC Apps. But Don't Want Two Boxes.

- **Departments Need Mac:** Creative departments and others need Mac hardware and apps to get their work done. But enterprise-wide applications, like Office 2007, Sharepoint, Internet Explorer, and Outlook need Windows to run. And a separate physical PC next to that Mac is just another machine to maintain and depreciate.

The Solution: Provision a Windows virtual machine with VMware Fusion on that Mac. The user gets his Mac-based line of business apps *and* his Windows apps—all on one box. One less endpoint to manage, one more happy end user.

▪ Macs on the menu:

- **Desktop of Choice:** MacBook Pros are renowned as excellent laptops, and have that “Mac cool” that many users love. The MacBook Air is an attractive ultraportable for road warriors. But Enterprise apps often need Windows....

The Solution: VMware Fusion, running a standard Windows XP or Windows Vista virtual machine. Leverage the same desktop software and management systems for physical XP & Vista machines to patch & manage VMware Fusion-based VMs.

Support Macs without changing your people or processes.

▪ Employee Owned. Virtually Managed.

- **Bring Your Own Mac:** With Apple's market share rising in the laptop realm faster than any other segment, consultants, contractors, and others are more and more likely to have a personal Mac to support in your environment.

The Solution: A standard-issue Windows XP or Windows Vista virtual machine, provisioned onto VMware Fusion, is a seamless way to support those employee-owned Macs. No need to deploy a loaner laptop when a VM will do nicely.
